# EXPLORE WILDERNESS ADVENTURES

y first wilderness canoe trip was an experience that impacted me in a profound way. I remember becoming very frustrated as I tried to keep my canoe moving straight. To this day I have stayed in touch with that trip leader and he has become an important part of how the Lord has shaped my life's journey.

People who have embarked on wilderness trip programs will agree that camping, hiking, and canoeing have an impact on a young person's growth and development. It is for that reason that LBE is launching the new and exciting Explore! Wilderness Adventures program this summer.

Our desire is to use these nature-oriented and physical experiences to introduce youth to Christ, teach Biblical truths and put our youth in a position to succeed while facing risk and challenge. Explore! will provide much needed opportunities for teamwork, leadership training, and healthy exercise. This summer we will have overnight wilderness camps and week-long canoe trips. This program will continue into the fall with after-school events and adventure clubs.

In order to make this vision come alive, we are in the process of recruiting and raising up a team of volunteers to aid us in teaching and mentoring youth in these outdoor programs. We are inviting anyone who enjoys the outdoors, loves youth, and feels they have a personal mission to teach Biblical truths, to call and let us know about your passion.

For many of our youth, this summer will be the first time they will ever go on a canoe trip. For others it may be another trip to take them to the next level of leadership. We are

## EXPLORERS BIBLE CAMP

his summer is full of big and exciting changes at Explorers Bible Camp. The Camp team (Allie, Amanda, Miriam and Kris) are working with our renovated and enhanced camp property, complete with a man-made lake that has more than doubled in size since last year. We have gravel hills, a challenge course, and new equipment such as canoes, paddles, life jackets and much more. There is also an improved layout featuring a soccer field, a new archery pitch, and a wilderness outpost.

This summer we are running three co-ed kids' camps, one all girls' camp, and one jr. teens' camp. As many of our counselors and junior leaders are teenagers, we are running a week of training before these weeks of camp begin. During this training week, we will be teaching the junior leaders how to run the skills activities, such as archery and canoeing. Our main focus is teaching the counselors about ministering to the young people. We will be discussing how to meet their emotional, physical and spiritual needs, covering subjects such as prayer and how to handle difficult behavioural situations that may arise.

We are also very excited to announce our first annual Explorers Family Camp. Our dream for this camp is to bring 6-10 families for 3 days and 2 nights of camp. Our family camp will have the typical camp experience for the families, with some resting and relaxing time for the parents as well as a time where families to do activities together. Our guest speaker, Robert Wilson (aka Christian rap artist Fresh IE) will be teaching on the promises of God for families, the consequences of generational sin and the blessings of God for families that honour him.

This is a big summer of firsts for the Explorers Bible Camp team, as we are introducing two brand new camps: our Leadership Training camp and our Family Camp. We are excited about the possibilities and the opportunities we are presenting to the young people and their families this summer and we are praying for God to move mightily in the lives of Winnipeg's inner-city residents.

#### **Construction at Camp**

Longer days and great weather are helping us complete the preparation work for camp start up. Unfortunately, the mosquitoes are horrendous, but we are enduring this difficulty as it comes with the territory. We have worked to prepare the camp cabins for our June weekend camps with the teens. We are now racing against time to see our fourth duplex cabin framed and roofed for summer use. The concrete floor will be poured the last week of June and then the carpentry will begin.

Special thanks to volunteers who have been helping: Sean Barkwell, Preston Linklater, Jack Penner, and David and Phillip Thiessen (brothers from Hadashville). Special thanks to Mel Taylor who built another two picnic tables for camp. We also want to thank the Salvage Supermarket for truckloads of donated items of reclaimed building materials.
